- Full paper to be submitted by 25th of July, 2024.

Guidelines:

- 10 minutes will be provided for a paper presentation.
- +2 minutes for discussion.
- Selected papers shall be allowed to present at the conference.
- The maximum number of participants per paper is three.
- The paper presentation should be in APA format.
- The paper should be 2000 2500 words.
- Paper must be preceded by a cover page specifying the title of the paper, names of authors, and their college names as also their contact numbers and email ids.
- The decision of judges will be final, and no arguments or appeals will be entertained.
- The papers presented will be published as conference proceedings.
- Each registered individual can present only one paper.

Cash prize of Rs 10,000 for the best paper presentation

Competitions for students

Events highlighting the theme including mental health awareness shall be organized. These are available for offline participants only.

- Painting: Painting representing the theme using watercolours within the time limit. It is an individual event. Materials shall be carried by the participants. Only cardboard sheet shall be provided.
- Short video: Short video of 3 minutes highlighting the theme involving maximum of 3 participants should be recorded in our college campus.
 This video shall be screened in this schedule and the participants needs to answer the questions by judges if any.
- Best counsellor: Every participant shall have to exhibit their counselling skills by playing the role of a counsellor in the mock counselling arranged for 10 minutes.
- Monoact: Mono act relating to the theme for maximum 3 minutes.
- One minute of fame: Individual participant shall present their talent within one minute.
- Dance: Dance of any form considering the theme for maximum 4 minutes.
 Solo or group with maximum 5.
- **Quiz**: This shall be an individual event. 30 Multiple choice questions should be answered within 30 minutes. Time and number of correct responses are considered.
- **Treasure hunt:** 2 participants in a team shall crack the 4 dumb charades presented to them. Team which solves the 4 dumb charades, passes the four levels and reaches the treasure will be the winners.

First two winners in all the events shall be awarded. The one who wins maximum number of prizes shall be awarded as "Star of the carnival"
